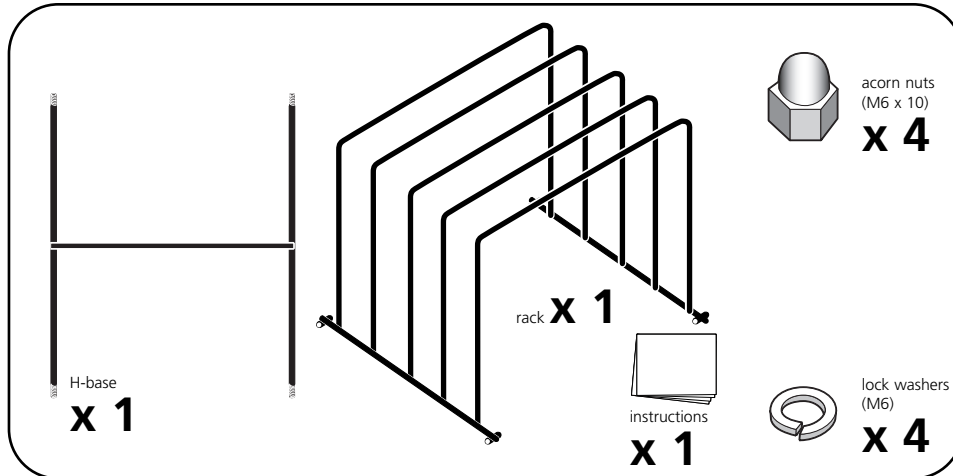


Assembly Instructions for — BR20 Compact Big-Book Rack

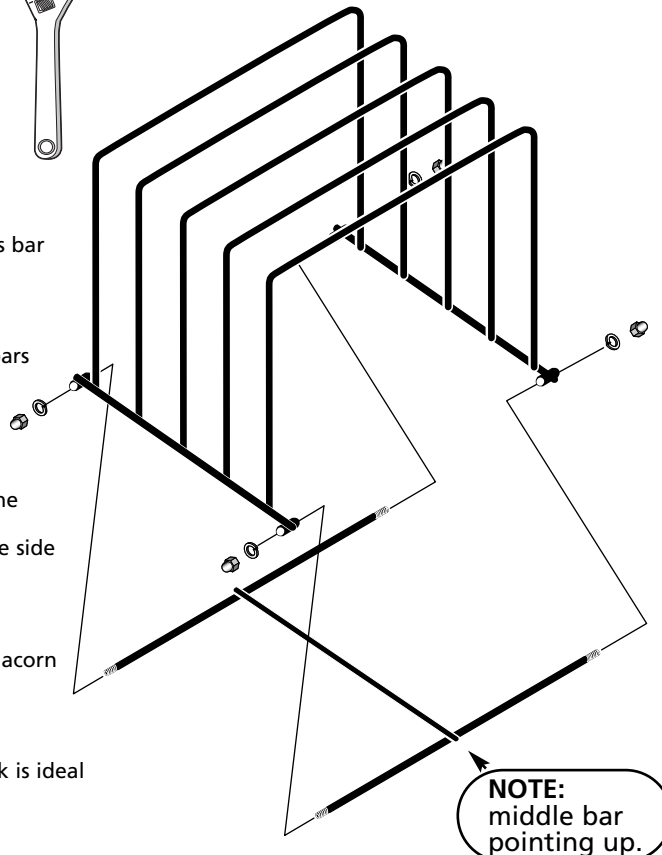
Adjustable wrench.

Note: metric hardware



Assembly:

1. Place H-Base flat with the cross bar on top.
2. Insert one side of the H-base bars through holes in rack ends on one side of H-base. Align other side and slide through the second set of holes on opposite side of the rack.
3. Attach with lock washers, and acorn nuts.
4. Insert books vertically. This rack is ideal for counter tops.
