

## Masonry Wall Installation

**Hardware recommended for attaching the unit to a concrete wall. For other wall surfaces, please choose hardware accordingly.**




Measure and drill the two pilot holes on top, then hang the unit using the recommended hardware. For the bottom, drill the remaining three pilot holes through the holes in the unit and secure it with the hardware.


